1. INTRODUCTION

AWare retrieves the audio tracks from backup CDs created on Yamaha AW-series Professional Audio Workstations (AW4416, AW2816, AW16G).

2. SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

AWare is a Universal Binary application. It will run on Intel or PPC based Macs running Mac OSX 10.4, or greater.

3. INSTALLATION

The file you downloaded will automatically unzip and automount. It will appear as a disk image on your Desktop and a new Finder window will open, showing the contents of the package*.

1. Drag and drop the AWare icon onto the Applications icon.
That's it! Installation is complete. Skip to the next section.

*If the disk image fails to unpack and open automatically, follow the steps below.

1. Ctrl-click on the aware.zip file you downloaded.
2. Select "Open With..." and choose "Archive Utility".
3. Once file has unzipped, double-click on the .dmg file.
5. Go to step 1 (above) to finish installation.

4. REGISTRATION

In order to continue using AWare beyond the free trial period, you must purchase a license. After purchasing you will receive an email with your license file attached.

1. Save the license file somewhere on your computer.
2. Launch AWare.
3. Open the Preferences window from the main AWare menu.
4. Press the "Load License File" button in the Registration area.
5. Browse and select the license file you saved in step 1, above.
6. You should see a "License accepted" message.

5. OPENING BACKUP FILES

To open a backup file, choose "File -> Open..." from the AWare menu. Browse to the CD you inserted, and select the backup file.

1. For AW4416 and AW2816 backups, the file is named A00000_0.CFS
2. For AW16G backups, the file will be named AW_00000.16G

Once a song is loaded, it's tracks will appear in the track table. You must select (or highlight) tracks before they can be exported.

1. To select ALL tracks for export, go to the "Edit" menu and choose "Select All".
2. To select a multiple tracks, hold down the Command (Apple) Key while clicking on tracks.

Press the "Extract" button.

You will be prompted to select a location for the output files. AWare will automatically create a folder with the same name as the song.
